




Beck's Mill Hiking Trails


TRAIL DESCRIPTIONS

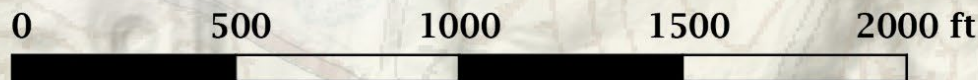
1) Mill Trail,
0.15 miles (red blaze). 
Short loop featuring rebuilt cabin and structures built by the Becks embedded with geodes.

2) Cemetery Trail,
0.3 miles (red blaze). 
The cemetery contains graves of the Becks and their neighbors dating to the early 1800s.

3) Mill Creek Overlook Trail,
1.1 miles (white blaze). 
This trail passes by the cemetery and continues to overlooks of Mill Creek near an old stone quarry.

4) Sulphur Springs Trail,
1.8 miles (blue blaze). 
This extension of the Mill Creek Overlook Loop Trail passes springs that flow from the side of a hill over large rocks and follows a scenic bluff above Mill Creek.

5) Spring View Trail,
0.5 miles (orange blaze). 
From the cemetery, this trail passes above Sulphur Springs to connect with the Sulphur Springs Trail.



All trails start and end at the mill. The trails are rugged and may require you to cross flowing streams. GATES CLOSE AT 4:00 PM.
